During the second quarter we:

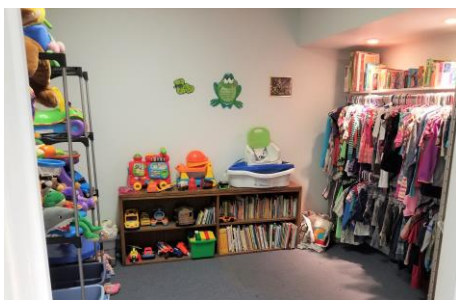
- Served 166 people

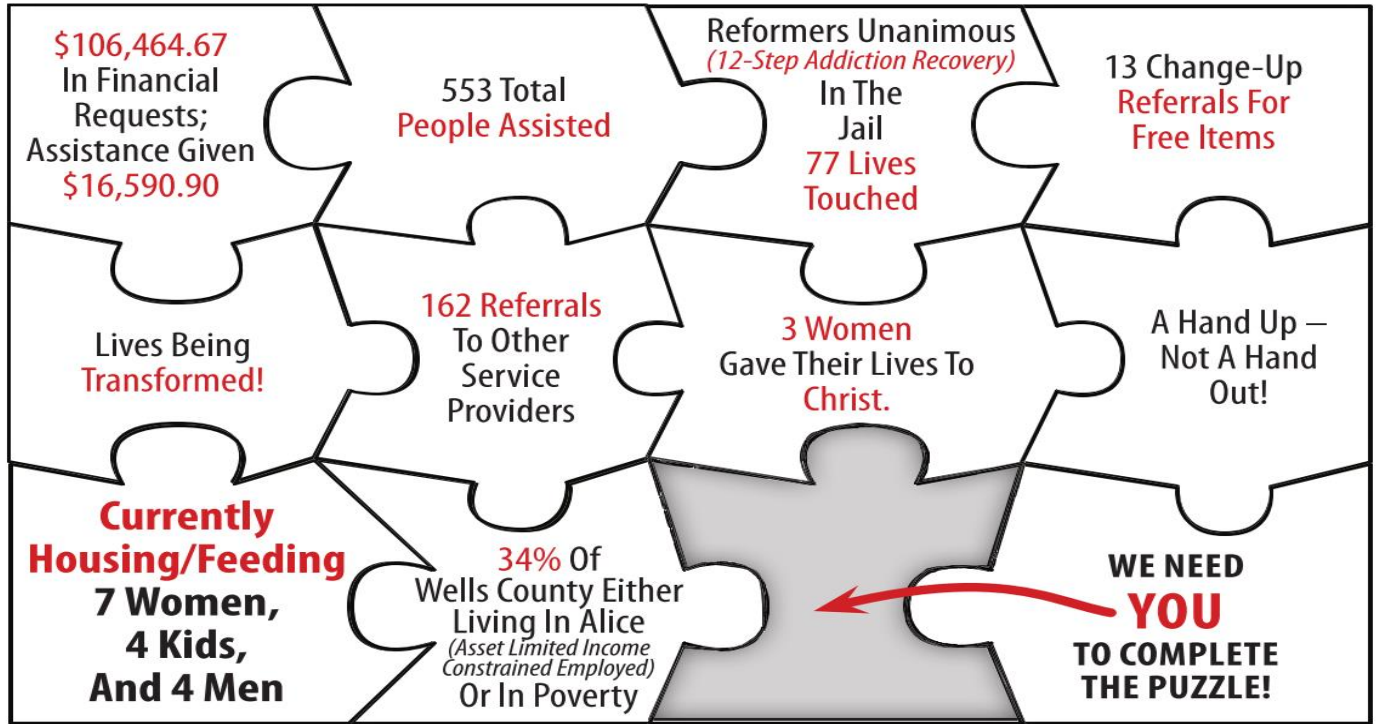
